## "A Solid Foundation"

"The wise man built his house upon a rock ...". Long before those words became a staple VBS song, Jesus spoke them as He closed out the Sermon on the Mount. "Therefore, whoever hears these words of mine and puts them into practice is like a wise man who built his house on a rock. The rain came down and the streams rose and the winds blew and beat against the house; yet it did not fall because it had its foundation on the rock." (Matthew 7:24-25)

Throughout the Sermon on the Mount, Jesus had been warning His listeners (that's you and me also!) about basing your life on the sandy foundation. He warned against arrogance: "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of God". He warned against self-righteousness: "...unless your righteousness surpasses that of the Pharisees and the teachers of the law, you will certainly not enter the kingdom of heaven". He warned against thinking that our thoughts and motives don't matter: 5:12-6:15. He warned about building your foundation on earthly things: "Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth". He warned against hypocrisy: "For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged". He warned about following the broad way and entering the wide gate. He warned that following Him is more than just calling Him, "Lord". He said all of this in an effort to help us see that true foundation that will last during the storms of life.

That lasting foundation is one built on humility, forgiveness, sincerity and obedience. Jesus said, "But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness and all these things will be given to you as well". We know all too well that the rain and rising water and winds of life will best against our spiritual house. We've seen and experienced illness, death, financial troubles, family struggles and so on. But it is our foundation of faith, trust and hope that helps us weather these storms.

Thank you for your patience and endurance as we've studied together these important words of Jesus. I hope your life has been and will continue to be blessed, as mine had, by our study together.

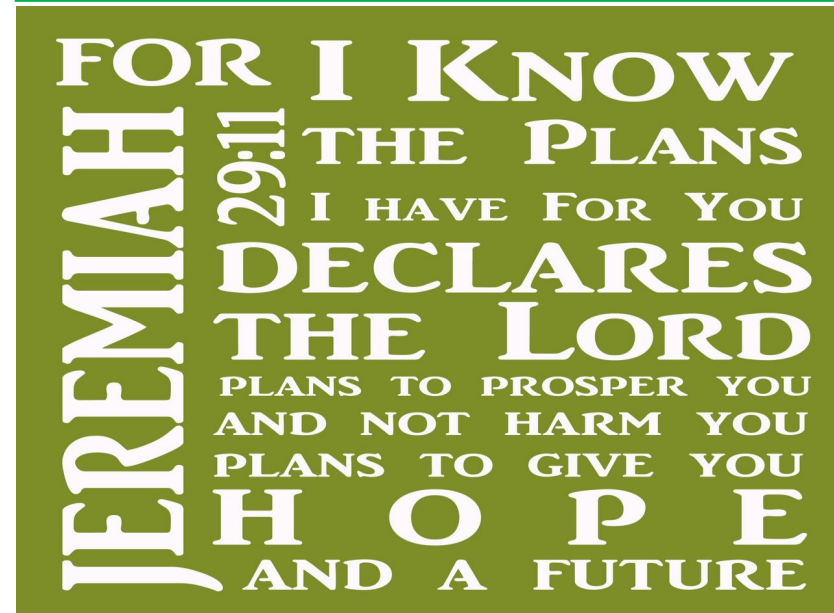
**UPDATE-PRAYER LIST**
