"LAVISHED"

"Lavished". Think about that word for a minute. It's not one that we use that often. Webster defines it as, "expended or produced in abundance; marked by excess". Now think about these words from 1 John 3:1: "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us, that we should be called children of God!". What John seems to be trying to get us to realize is that God has not just rationed His love for us. He has not merely sprinkled us with His love. Even though that would have been enough. That would have been sufficient. He could have given us just enough love to save from our sins and nothing more. Like the prodigal son, who would have accepted a position as a servant on his return, simply being saved from the despair of eternal punishment would have been enough.

But God never does just enough. He always goes beyond. No, He has "lavished" His love on us. "Lavished" to the point of making us His children. Joint-heirs with Christ, our brother. Beneficiaries of His estate. What a truly awesome thought. And what a truly awesome cost. This "lavished" love was at the cost of His Son. Romans tells us, "God demonstrate His own love toward us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." (Romans 5:8). John writes, "This is how God showed His love among us: He sent His one and only Son into the world that we might live through Him." (1 John 4:9).

I left out the last part of 1 John 3:1 on purpose. Let's read it again: "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us that we should be called children of God! AND THAT IS WHAT WE ARE!". So, John writes, we should live like children of God. No longer a possession of Satan, no longer a servant to sin. But, a child of God, displaying the characteristics of our Father in all we do.
